

Enjoy each day to the fullest. Find pleasure in the small things in life and be thankful for what you have. Life is short so enjoy each and every moment!


#### What are you most likely to be remembered for at HEHS?



#### What are you most likely to be remembered for at HEHS?


That my goal was what was best for the development of kids—educationally, motivationally, socially, athletically...
